Thankfully it was blessed with good weather and hosted 475+ people of all ages from the community and beyond. The headline act Ben Waters didn't disappoint and gained many new fans.</p> <p>Although the main focus of the day wasn't to raise money pleasingly the event raised significant funds that will be paid directly into the CCIO account. Additionally, the raffle raised £400.00 towards the skate-park project and a Team from the Church raised a further £257.85 towards their on-going infrastructure costs.</p> <p><b>Members response:</b> The EC Team were congratulated on the success of the event and acknowledged how many volunteers had been involved on the day. In addition, members resolved unanimously to waiver £500.00 and ask for just £2500.00 to be repaid as the Council had loaned the Entertainments Committee monies to secure the early booking of the headline act – therefore the amount raised from the event is £1825.36.</p>
